Project SHARE always follows our schedule so it will begin at 1:35.

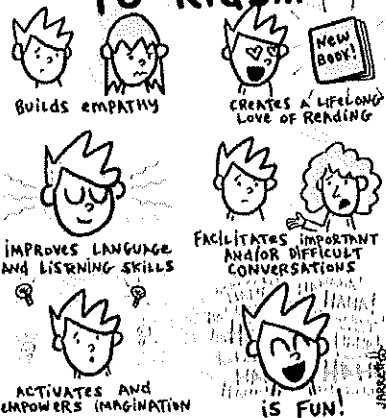
FGWS BEAUTIFICATION

**READING ALOUD
to Kids...**



Parents, if you did nothing else but read to and with your children each night for as little as 10-20 minutes, the pay back is immense. The cadence of the read word is different than conversational speech. Young children "hear" you wrap one line into the other- a learned reading skill that takes practice instead of stopping at the end of a line. Expression and use of different voices for different characters brings the content and action to life. These gains don't stop with beginning readers either. The content and story lines of "young adult" books are thought provoking not only for kids but adults as well.
