COVID

Madatory 10 day quarantines are no longer required if testing positive for Covid. If after 5 days there are no symptoms and a person tests negative they may return to school. It is advised that a mask be worn for an additional 5 days. If a family member tests positive, a student may continue to come to school as long as they remain symptom free. A Covid test should be taken on day 3 or day 5 of the onset of symptoms or positive testing of the family member. It is advised that masks be worn at school by those who have a family member testing positive for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or positive test.

The school has many covid tests on site for free. Please don't hesitate to ask if you need some. Two children in our school community tested positive this morning. They tested at home and have not had contact with FGWS students since Friday.
