Live Drug Free.** Although the message of a drug free life style is touted throughout the year for our older students through various assemblies and talks, in October it is highlighted with special emphasis. Included in this are health related concerns regarding tobacco and tobacco related products including e-cigarettes and all vaping devices.

The littles are cautioned about being lured into a car with a stranger with promises of candy, puppies or kittens. We don't want children fearful of people in general, but they need to know not to go with a stranger no matter how enticing the come on. One suggestion is for families to have a special code word that is only shared among family members. If someone says to a small child, "Your mom sent me to pick you up," the child should ask the code word. If the "stranger" cannot produce it, s/he knows this is not a mom approved situation. This also applies to phone scams. Don't fall prey to the cockroaches roaming among us. Please rest assured that we will not release a child from school without your approval. It is important to keep your release information updated!

Every family should have a fire evacuation plan for their home. A central meeting place is essential so that no one goes back inside to rescue someone who is already safe. A large tree, the end of the drive way or other easily accessed home landmark is suggested.
