PROJECT SHARE

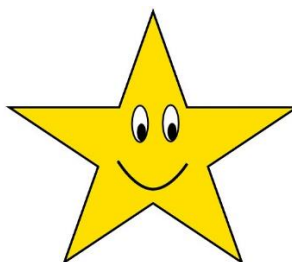
Just wanted to post a few housekeeping matters associated with Project SHARE. If you wish to allow your older student permission to check him/herself out of the program, please send in a written note that specifies dates, times, etc. Once a student leaves SHARE, they are not allowed to return to the program until the next day. FGWS, unlike so many other schools in the county, has an open campus after school hours of operation are over. Be advised that this time frame includes the hours that SHARE is in session. It runs until 6:00 pm each day. If not checked into SHARE, students are not allowed back on campus to play basketball or use the play equipment until after 6:00 pm. This policy allows our SHARE liaison to focus her attention on those students who are under her immediate responsibility and supervision.

Although FGWS is a small school, our kids did an amazing job on the CAASPP test this past spring. The results were just released. Given the lockdown in 2020 in addition to starting 2020-21 with a hybrid program we couldn't be more proud of the achievement of our students. Because we only tested 10 students, the results themselves cannot be made public without potentially violating the privacy of individual students. Most of our students far exceeded the state averages for both English Language Arts and Mathematics at all grade level 3rd-8th. Students, teachers, aides and parents, give yourselves pats on the back for a job well done.
